All Clubs and swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ and Eligibility:

other World Aquatics affiliated Federations.

Age Group ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31,2022.

Masters must be 25 years and over as at December 31, 2023.

Registration: The ASAJ Register closes at 4:00 pm May 19, 2023.

Entry Limit: Individual events - four (4) events per swimmer per session

Relay events - three (3) entries per Club.

All events will be swum as timed finals. There will be a limit on heats for 10 & under events of distances 100 M and longer as well as 11 & over

events of distances 200 M and over.

9-10 400 M Freestyle 1 heat, top 8 All 10 & under events 100 M & 200 M 2 heats top 16 All 11 & over 200 M events and above 3 heats top 24 1500 M Freestyle 1 heat top 8

Deck Entries: Deck Entries will be permitted. Deck entries are not restricted to

> swimmers entered in the Meet, however swimmers must be registered with the ASAJ or a World Aquatics affiliated club. One day registration

for Masters will be accepted.

Time Trials: Time trials will be permitted and will be swum at the beginning of

> each session, at the discretion of the meet referee. Swimmers must request time trials at least 60 minutes before the start of the session.

Entry Fees: Individual Entries - Using Hy-Tek

J\$600.00 per event for ASAJ registered swimmers.

US\$4.00 per event for Non-ASAJ/World Aquatics registered swimmers.

Surcharge: J\$800.00 per swimmer

Relays Entries – Using Hy-Tek

J\$1000 per relay for ASAJ registered Clubs

US\$ 6.00 per relay team per Non-ASAJ /World Aquatics Clubs

Relay Deck entries \$2000 per relay US \$12

Rules: World Agutics Rules and ASAJ Byelaws in force at the time of the

competition will apply, and World Aquatics Masters Rules will apply to

Masters events except as modified in this summons.

Officials: Referees and Starters on the World Aquatics Swimming Lists no. 21 & 22

will officiate at each session.

Timeline: There will be a strict adherence to the time limits of each session.

Protests: All protests to the referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in





writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of the disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$1,500 or US\$12.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.

Jury Of Appeal: There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a

> Referee's rejection of a protest. Each club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries. The Jury of Appeal shall comprise three (3) persons drawn from the pool of nominees submitted by

each club.

Warm Up: World Aquatics Warm Up Guidelines will be enforced. Clubs will be

assigned warm up lanes based on the number of swimmers entered in the

Meet.

Relay Cards: Relay cards must be completed in duplicate, and handed to the computer

> operator thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the session. Any change must be made at least two (2) events prior to the scheduled relay, after that the presentation of a medical certificate will be required for changes. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming

in accordance with World Aquatics rules.

Positive Check-In: There will be positive check-in 45 minutes before the start of the session

> for all events 400 M and above. Coaches may positively check-in their swimmers. Swimmers who miss their event after they have checked in must pay a penalty of J\$1,500.00 to continue participating in the meet.

Marshaling: There will be no marshaling for the meet. Swimmers must be behind the

> timekeepers at the start area at least one event before their race. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress. Coaches are responsible for getting their swimmers to the

starting block on time.

The Start: Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he is in control of

the race after the second whistle, no swimmer may enter the race. If this

occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.





Swim Up: Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group.

Scratches: Scratches are allowed at any time, except after a positive check in.

Points: Points will be awarded in three categories: Age Group, Masters and

Overall.

Points will be assigned in the following groups:

Age group: 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17 and 18-24.

Masters: 25-34, 35-44, 45-54 and 55 & over.

Unattached swimmers will not score team points but will be eligible for individual awards.

#### **Individual Events**

Points will be awarded for all events as follows:

9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1st to 8th place

13 & over events swum together will be scored according to the age Groups 13-14, 15-17, and 18-24.

Masters may swim events 9-10, 45-46, 59-60, 89-90 in the 13 & over group but will score according to the Age Groups 25-34, 35-44, 45-54 and 55 & over.

#### Relay events:

Points will be awarded for all relay events as follows:

18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for 1st to 8th place.

Where clubs do not have enough swimmers to make a relay. Teams of Club and unattached swimmers may swim as a relay for exhibition purposes only. These relays can be submitted during the session as a deck entry. Deck entry fees will apply.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the first three (3) places in all events. Ribbons

will be awarded to 10 & under swimmers placing 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>

A trophy will be awarded to the overall winning club in the Age group and Masters categories as well as overall winning club combined age

group and Masters.





Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) high point swimmers in each Age Group Category.

There will be a trophy for the swimmer in each age group who achieves the highest World Aquatics points in an event of distances 200 M or longer.
