1. INVITED COUNTRIES

The Association also extends a special invitation to Anguilla and Antigua & Barbuda to celebrate the XXIX Annual Goodwill Swimming Championship 2025.

2. COMPETITION DATES & GAMES VILLAGE

The schedule for this competition shall be as follows:

4. LOCATION & POOL SPECIFICATIONS

The Goodwill Swimming Championship 2025 will be held at the Barbados Aquatic Centre, Wildey, St. Michael, Barbados. Daktronics Electronic Timing with Hy-Tek Software will be in effect using 8 Lanes of the 50m Competition Pool in Short Course configuration and a 25m cool down pool. Timing will be semi-automatic with touch pads on the start end of the pool and hand times used as back-up.

6. ENTRIES

6.1 Preliminary Entries

Preliminary Entries must be submitted to the Barbados Aquatic Sports Association Office at <u>barbadosaquatics@olympic.org.bb</u> on or before **June 22**, **2025** on the attached form via email.

6.2 Final Entries

Final Entries must be submitted by 11:59pm July 20, 2025, in Hy Tek entry file format. The entry file will be emailed to your Federation on receipt of the preliminary entry form.

6.3 Accreditation

Photographs of all athletes and officials are to accompany your final entries, and they must be submitted in JPEG or PNG format.

6.4 Rooming List & Arrival & Departures

Federations are to submit their arrival and departure information including flight numbers as well as their rooming list with their final entries as per the attached forms.

7. COMPETITION RULES

- All heats will be timed finals.
- World Aquatics rules in effect at the time of the competition shall apply. Note especially WA Rule SW 4.4 – Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given shall be disqualified.
- Starts may be over the top in the freestyle, breaststroke and butterfly events with exception of the 50m events at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
- Swimmers are required to be in the Marshalling Area at least 3 heats before their race.
- The warmup routine shall be an open lane format with controlled sprinting in designated lanes.

8. Protests

- The Organizing Committee of the Goodwill Swimming Championship 2025 and the Jury of Appeal shall have complete authority to answer and resolve any interpretation, resolution and call relating to the Goodwill Swimming Championship 2025. Nominations for the Jury of Appeal should be submitted at the Technical Meeting on Thursday, August 14, 2025.
- All protests to the Referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within thirty (30) minutes after the race, signed by the Delegation's leader and accompanied by a US\$ 25.00 fee. If the protest is upheld the fee would be returned to the Delegation's Official.
- All protests rejected by the Referee shall be referred to the Jury of Appeal. The decision of the Jury of Appeal shall be final.

9. ELIGIBILITY

Competitors must either be citizens or residents of the country they are seeking to represent. Naturalized Citizens and residents must have resided in that country for at least 12 months prior to the competition. A letter from the School, Club or Federation must be provided as Proof of Residency and must be submitted at the Secretariat.

10. AGE GROUPS

- 8 & Under
- 9 to 10
- 11 to 12
- 13 to 14
- 15 to 17
- The age of the swimmer on December 31, 2024 shall determine the agegroup in which he/she is eligible to compete. Proof of age must be submitted at the Technical Meeting.
- Swimmers who participated in the CARIFTA, CCCAN, CONSANAT Swimming Championships or higher competitions during 2025 are not eligible to compete.

11. ENTRY RULES

- Each Federation may enter a maximum of four (4) swimmers per gender, per age-group up to a maximum total of forty (40) athletes.
- Each Federation may enter a maximum of three (3) swimmers per event of which Three (3) competitors are eligible for medals and only TWO (2) will score points.
- There is no limit to the number of events in which a swimmer may participate

12. TEAM OFFICIALS

Each National Federation may send the following number of officials, based on the total number of swimmers comprising the team:

13. AWARDS

- Medals will be awarded to the first, second and third place finishers in each event.
- Trophies will be given to the male and female gaining the most points in each age-group.
- The Championship Trophy will be given to the team amassing the highest total points.

- Three (3) Country flags no larger than four (4) feet by six (6) feet
- A compact disk or MP3 file with the short & long versions of their National Anthem.

16. CULTURAL PRESENTATION & GIFT EXCHANGE

• There will be a cultural presentation and Gift Exchange at the closing ceremony.

17. FEES

- The official delegation shall pay US\$170.00 per night, US\$680 per person for the period August 14 to 18, 2025, based on 4 persons per room; meals and transportation inclusive.
- For those federations requiring room occupancy other than quadruple the following rates will be charged:
 - US\$ 180.00 per person for Triple occupancy room, board and local transportation between the competition venues and athlete's village
 - US\$ 203.00 per person for Double occupancy room, board and local transportation between the competition venues and athlete's village
- Aquatic Centre Entrance Fee (one Time) US\$ 25.00 per swimmer. This offer is valid only for the stipulated period.
- Please be advised that 50% of the payment due is required by July 4, 2025 to allow the Organizing Committee to secure the Games Village. You must include in the payment the related bank charges that will be incurred by the Organizing Committee when the funds are deposited in its bank account.
