

# 2017 MILO PREP/PRIMARY SCHOOLS SWIMMING <br> CHAMPIONSHIPS, JUNE 2-3, 2017 <br> ASAJ SANCTION \#31707 

VENUE: $\quad$ National Aquatic Centre, Independence Park, Kingston 6 (50M Pool)
DATES \& TIMES: Friday June 2, 2017 - 8:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.
(Preliminaries/Heats)
Saturday June 3, 2017 - 9:00 a.m. (Finals)
The Pool will be open for warm-up $11 / 2$ hours before the starting time for each session

OPENING CEREMONY: Friday June 2, 2017 at 8:15 am.
ELIGIBILITY: All Preparatory and Primary Schools are invited to attend.
Ages for the competition shall be as of midnight on August 31, 2016.
ENTRY LIMITS: Number of events per swimmer:- Five (5) including relays and open events.
Number of Individual entries per school: - three (3) per event (see note below).
Number of Relay entries per school: - two (2) per Relay event.

- Entry limit in the 50 metre freestyle is five (5) swimmers

All 7 \& over 50 m and 100 m Individual and 200 m Relay events will have one (1) final except for the 50 m Free which will have 2 finals an ' $A$ ' - Top 8 and ' $B$ ' - for places 9 to 16.

## N. B. All 6 \& U events will be swum as Timed Finals on Saturday

## - Events 1 - $4 \mathbf{2 0 0}$ m Individual Medley 10 \& under and 11 - 12 will be swum as Timed Finals on Saturday.

## - Events with 8 or less entrants will be swum as timed finals on Saturday

ENTRY FEES: J\$300.00 per swimmer.
J\$500.00 per relay entry
Entry fees are to be paid before the start of the competition. If not, a penalty equal to $15 \%$ of the entry fees will be added.

RULES: $\quad$ FINA rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at time of competition will apply. For additional rules and regulations see next page.

PROGRAMME: All events (except 1 to 4 and all 6 \& Under events) will be swum as heats and finals. The eight (8) fastest swimmers/relay teams in the preliminary heats will swim in the final on Saturday. Swimmers 7 \& over will have 2 finals of top 16 for the 50 m Free events.

ENTRY DEADLINE: 4:00 p.m. - Friday May 19, 2017. ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED VIA HYTEK SOFTWARE. MANUAL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Entries are to be e-mailed to aquaticsja@gmail.com . The entry list (sorted by swimmer) from Hytek Team Manager MUST be delivered to the ASAJ OFFICE at the NATIONAL AQUATIC CENTRE, Independence Park, duly signed by the Principal of the School, and stamped. TECHNICAL MEETING: There will be no technical meeting All changes to Hy-Tek entries submitted MUST be reviewed and ALL corrections done electronically via email correspondence.

## NOTE:

1. ENTRY TIMES MUST BE STATED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT
2. RELAY ENTRIES MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE ENTRIES WITH ENTRY TIME
3. CORRECT DATE OF BIRTH OF EACH COMPETITOR MUST BE INCLUDED
4. ENTRY FEES SHOULD BE PAID BY THE ENTRY DEADLINE - NB: ENTRY FEES PAID AFTER THE START OF COMPETITION WILL INCUR A 15\% LATE PAYMENT PENALTY.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Arm Bands will be provided for Meet Officials, School Volunteers and Swim Coaches
2. SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS: - Each school entering less than t we $n t y(20)$ swimmers must provide a minimum of two (2) volunteers e.g. timekeepers per session. Schools entering twe nt y (20) or more swimmers must provide at least three (3). PLEASE NOTE:

- THE NAMES OF THE REQUIRED SCHOOL TECHNICAL OFFICIALS AND VOLUNTEERS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE ENTRIES (SCHOOL PASSES WILLNOTBEISSUEDUNTILTHE NAMES ARE SUBMITTED TO THE ASAJ OFFICE).
- SCHOOLVOLUNTEERSMUSTREPORTTOTHEOFFICIALS, C O O R D I N AT O R AT LE AS T SIXTY (60) MINUTES BEFORE THE START OF EACH SESSION.
- SCHOOLS THAT DO NOT PROVIDE THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF OFFICIALS W I LL N O T BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PARTICULAR SESSION.

3. The FINA Starting rule SW4.4 will apply - Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be disqualified.

## MARSHALLING:

1. There will be no Marshalling area for the preliminary heats. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress. Coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.
2. Marshalling will be provided for the FINALS ONLY - the fi rst ( $1^{\text {st }}$ ) and second ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ ) alternates must be in the marshalling area, along with the finalists, at least four (4) events prior to their event.

## ENTRIES AND RESULTS:

1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their respective Age Group
2. All swimmers entered must be registered with their School.
3. Scratches and name spelling corrections and checking of the original entry MUST be done via email no later than, May 26, 2017.
4. Deck entries and times trials will not be allowed.
5. Scratches are allowed at any time.
6. Relay cards must be handed in to the Recorder thirt y ( 30 ) minutes before the start of the first event of the session. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with FINA rules. Any change must be made at least four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that, on presentation of a medical certificate. Relay teams who qualify for the finals may substitute swimmers.

## AWARDS AND POINTS

1. Points will be awarded for the top eight (8) places in each individual event as follows: $9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1$.
2. For all relay events, points will be awarded to the top eight (8) places: 18 14, 12,10,8,6,4,2.
3. For 50 m freestyle events 7 \& Over, points will be awarded to the top 16 places: $18,16,15$, $14,13,12,11,10,9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1$.
4. Medals will be awarded to the first, second and third place swimmers in each timed final event and in the Championship Finals only. Swimmers who finish fourth to eighth in the finals of the Individual events on I y will be awarded ribbons.
5. Trophies will be awarded as follows:

- The Nestle Shield will be awarded to the overall winning school (combined points).
- Trophies will be awarded to the second and third place schools (combined points).
- Trophies will be awarded to the Preparatory School that wins the female and the male Division.
- $\square$ AAtrophy will be awarded to the Top Primary School.
- $\square$ A Male and Female High Point Trophy will be awarded to the individual that scores the most points in each age group.
- A Spirit Award will be given to the school deemed to have exhibited the best team spirit (Cheering, sportsmanship etc.)
