

ASAJ ARTISTIC SWIMMING COMPETITION & NATIONAL TEAM TRIALS July 01,2023, Kingston, Jamaica, W.I.

The Aquatic Sports Association of Jamaica (ASAJ) invites eligible clubs and swimmers to participate in the **Artistic Swimming Development Meet to take** place **Saturday July,01,2023**, *in Kingston, Jamaica*. The competition is being held under the sanction of the ASAJ.

ASAJ SANCTION#: 22318

DATE OF COMPETITION: Saturday, July 01,2023

COMPETITION: The competition will consist of Super novice, Novice, Intermediate, Age group figures and routines and Junior and Senior technical routines.

VENUE: NAC, National Aquatic Center, Kingston, Jamaica.

MEET MANAGERS: Olga Novokshchenova, Robyn-Ann Chin Sang

RULES:

- A combination of FINA 2017-2022 and 2023-2027 rules will be followed. Unless otherwise specified, FINA and ASAJ Bylaws and Regulations in force at time of competition.
- An Artistic swimmer's age group shall be determined by the age of the swimmer as of midnight on 31st December 2023.
- Age Categories: Novice and Super Novice 12& under, 13 & over, Intermediate, Age group: 12& under, Age group: 13-15, Junior and Senior.
- An athlete may compete in an older age group for the duet, trio and team competition as long as at least one of the swimmers is in the relevant age group
- Age Group competitors may not swim in a younger age group.
- Any swimmer who is listed as an alternate for duet or team shall pay the relevant entry fee.
- If Swimmer placed in the top 3 in the Super novice category in the previous meet (February 2023). The athlete cannot enter the super novice category!
- Athletes may compete in figures only.



ELIGIBILITY: All swimmers who are registered members of a FINA Federation, Club or a school team.

- Super Novice & Novice: 12&U (2011 or later) 13&O (2010 and earlier)
- Age group 12&U: (2011 or later) Age group 13-15 (2010-2008) Juniors (2010 and earlier) Seniors (2007 and earlier)

DELEGATIONS: There is no limit to the number of athletes.

- 4B Fishtail Continuous Spin 720° 2.6
- 5B Rocket Split Bent Knee 2.1

Juniors & Seniors, Duet Technical Elements

- 1B Walkover back closing 180°-Continuous spin 720° 2.5
- 2B Rocket Split-Spinning 180° 2.4
- 3B Flamingo Half twist Hybrid 2.6
- 4B Fishtail-Knight-Continuous spin 720° 2.7
- 5B Thrust Bent Knee Twirl 2.1

ROUTINES:

Super Novice: Each club location/school may enter a max of 2 routines that can either be duet, trio or team. Each swimmer can only participate in 2 routines. Special exemption may be given if the team is unable to participate in one of the stated categories. Routines should be 1:00 minute +/-5.

Novice: Each club location/school may enter 2 solos,2 duets, 2 trio and 1 team (max 8 swimmers). Each swimmer can only participate in 2 routines. Each routine MUST include the following elements: Kipnus, Boost, Front Walkover, Bent knee alternate and Barracuda. The elements can be performed in any order. Routines should be 1:30 +/-5.

Age group 12&U,13-15 and Intermediate: Each club location/school may enter 2 solos,2 duets, and 1 team (max 8 swimmers) in each of the Age groups. Intermediate and AG 12&U will be judged together. These routines are free routines. Routines should be 1:45 +/-5.

Junior/Senior- Each club location/school may enter 2 solos and 2 duets. These routines are technical routines. All elements MUST be performed in correct order. Routines should be 2:00 +/-5. (1) pair acrobatics must be performed in a duet technical routine.



MEET ENTRY FEES: JMD \$1000 per competitor for figures only, 1 Routine and Figures JMD\$2000. Every additional routine is JMD\$500.

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded for 1st through 3rd places in each category, ribbons/buttons 4th-8th.

OFFICIALS: Judges provided by the ASAJ. Practice judging isallowed.

PRELIM ENTRY DEADLINE: Friday June 16,2023.

FINAL ENTRY DEADLINE: Monday, June 26, 2023 (Payments must be made on or before to the ASAJ Artistic Swimming account (NCB- Savings-New Kingston- #354 214 334).

CANCELLATION POLICY: No Refund will be given if the swimmer drops out after June 26,2023.

SOUND EQUIPMENT: Each delegation is asked to email their music labeled with Competitor Name, Club, Age Category, Routine/Event. Alternatively, a thumb drive with the music clearly labeled as above for each routine may be presented.
