

## **ASAJ Time Trials # 1 May 8 – 9, 2021**

**ASAJ Sanction #:** 

Venue: National Aquatic Center: 8 Lane Competition Pool (with 25m Warm Up Pool)

Colorado Electronic Timing System (CTS6): pads with back-up buttons

**Date and Times:** Session 1 Sat AM 8.30 am -12.30 am 13 & Over

Session 2 Sun AM 8:30 am - 11:30 am 11 - 12

Pool will be opened 90 minutes before the start of the session

The pool will be closed for 60 minutes after the end of the morning session to

facilitate cleaning

Eligibility: All Clubs and Swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ. ONLY

locally based swimmers will be allowed to compete. Limited to the first 100 swimmers per session. All Clubs who wish to enter must have representation. Where the number of entrants exceed 100, Clubs will be asked to reduce the

number of swimmers they have entered.

Age groups according to the swimmer's age as at **December 31st, 2020.** 

Minimum Age of Entry: 11 years old

Registration: The ASAJ register closes on May 1, 2021 at 4:00 pm.

**Entry Fees:** N.B. ENTRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED VIA HY-TEK SOFTWARE.

J\$400 per swimmer per individual event

Entry fees are to be paid before the meet. (This will be strictly enforced. Clubs

that do not adhere to this will not be allowed to participate).

Date of birth for each swimmer must be included in the entry file.

**Entry Limits:** Maximum number of events per swimmer per session – Two (2) plus the Open

200m

200m Open: Swimmers may choose any 200 metre event. In the 200 time trial, Athletes swimming different strokes will be separated by 1 lane. **The 200 Open will be swum only if time allows.** The heats will be swum fastest to slowest. Swimmers' specific 200m stroke must be indicated in the entries. (If the event is

not swum, swimmers will be refunded the event entry fee.)



**Entry Deadline:** Entries are to be

submitted by May 2, 2021 by 4pm to asaj.meets@gmail.com

## No late entries will be accepted.

**Rules:** FINA Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition will

apply. FINA Starting rule SW 4 will apply

Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be

disqualified. See additional Rules and Regulations.

Additional Rules in regards to Covid-19 Protocols are included in the Protocols

**Programme:** All events will be swum in a timed final format.

**Additional Rules:** Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors

swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from

the event.

Deck entries will NOT be allowed.

Substitutions will NOT be allowed. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from

the event.

**Coaches:** Per Covid-19 Protocols.

**Marshalling:** There will be no Marshalling Area for the time trials. Swimmers are responsible

for following all racing protocols.

It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned

to him/her.

If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and they have taken control of the race (after the second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

**Scoring:** There will be no scoring in this time trial.
