

Bryden Hattie (CAN)

Diving

Bryden Hattie embarked on his journey representing Canada on the international stage in 2018, showcasing his remarkable talents at the prestigious Commonwealth Games held in Gold Coast. His inaugural appearance at the World Aquatics Championships in 2019 marked a significant milestone, where he demonstrated his prowess in the challenging 10m platform event. In a dazzling display of skill and excellence, Hattie secured two distinguished medals at the 2023 World Aquatics Diving World Cup. His triumphs were in the fiercely competitive mixed team 3m & 10m event, a testament to his dedication and mastery of the sport. At the Pan American Games, Hattie exhibited his versatility by participating in the 1m, 3m, and 3m synchronized events. In the individual 3M competition, he achieved a commendable 10th place, further solidifying his standing as a formidable force in the diving world.
