All Preparatory and Primary Schools are invited to participate. Ages for the meet shall be as of midnight August 31 ${ }^{\text {st }}, 2023$.

- Number of events per swimmer - five (5) including relays.
- Number of entries per school (individual) - three (3) per event, except 50M Freestyle - five (5) per event.
- 100 M and 200 M individual events will be limited to the fastest two heats.
- Number of entries per school (relays) - two (2) per relay event.
- All 7\&O events will have one (1) final except for the 50M Free which will have two (2) finals: an ' A ' - Top 8 and ' B ' - for places 9 to 16.
N.B. ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED VIA HY-TEK SOFTWARE. MANUAL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Aqua Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply. Aqua Starting rule SW 4 will apply - Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be disqualified. See additional Rules and Regulations on page 2 of this Summons.
$7 \& O$ events (except 200 IM ) will be contested in heats \& finals, the fastest eight (8) swimmers (plus two alternates) will return on Saturday for the Finals. All 6\&U events will be swam on Saturday as timed finals. See attached programme.

1. Individual entries must be indicated in the entry file with Seed Times.
2. Relay entries must be indicated in the entry file with Seed Times.

Relay-only swimmers MUST be declared on the entry.
3. The Date of Birth for each swimmer must be included in the Entry File.

TECHNICAL MEETING: There will be no technical meeting. Entries submitted by schools will be forwarded via email for verification by coach/school and corrections forwarded by return email.

## ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Schools must clear up any outstanding meet fee balances before their entries will be processed.
2. Complimentary arm bands will be provided for coaches, managers, school principals and timekeepers only.
3. Bands can be collected on meet day at the entrance gate upon presentation of a valid ID. Misuse will result in confiscation of the band and the appropriate disciplinary action taken against the offender and the respective school.
4. Schools are required to submit, with their entries, a list of volunteers to act as time keepers and to perform other duties essential to the smooth running of the competition. Time keepers will be assigned to their particular sessions and lanes at least two days before the start of the meet. Time keeper lane assignments will be emailed to the respective schools. Schools are expected to provide the following number of volunteers (non-compliant schools will be excluded from participation):

- 1-5 swimmers entered:

## MARSHALLING

1. There will be No Marshalling Area for the Preliminary Heats or Timed Finals. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
2. The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.
3. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.
4. Marshalling will be provided for the FINALS only. The first $\left(1^{\text {st }}\right)$ and second $\left(2^{\text {nd }}\right)$ alternates must be in the marshalling area, along with the finalists, at least four (4) events prior to their event.

## ENTRIES AND RESULTS

1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending school will be disqualified from the competition.
2. Deck entries and time trials will NOT be allowed.
3. Substitutions will NOT be allowed in individual events. Offending schools will be disqualified from the competition.
4. Substitutions for relays will be allowed. Relay cards are in duplicate, the original must be handed in to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the Session; the copy must be handed to the head lane time keeper at the beginning of the event. Any change must be made no later than four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that only on the presentation of a valid medical certificate. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with FINA rules.
5. All swimmers must be registered with their respective schools.
6. No late entries will be accepted unless in very extreme circumstances at the discretion of the ASAJ School Competitions Committee.

## AWARDS AND POINTS

1. Points for each event will be awarded as follows:

Individual Events (except 50M Free): 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for $1^{\text {st }}$ to $8^{\text {th }}$ place.
50M Freestyle: $18,16,15,14,13,12,11,10,9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1$ for $1^{\text {st }}$ to $16^{\text {th }}$ place.
Relay Events: $18,14,12,10,8,6,4,2$ for $1^{\text {st }}$ to $8^{\text {th }}$ place.
2. Medals will be awarded to the top three places in all Finals and Timed Finals (Individual and Relay). Ribbons will be awarded to $4^{\text {th }}$ through $8^{\text {th }}$ places in Individual Events only.
3. A Male and Female High Point Trophy will be awarded to the individual that scores the most points in each age group.
4. Team trophies will be awarded as follows:

- Trophies will be awarded to the Winner, $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ place of the Prep/Primary School in the female division.
- Trophies will be awarded to the Winner, $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ place of the Prep/Primary School in the male division .
- A Trophy will be awarded to the Overall winning Primary School.
- The Spirit Trophy will be awarded to the school that displays the best "spirit" throughout the day e.g. team cheering, sportsmanship etc.
