



2023 GOODWILL SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP

ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

The 2023 edition of the Goodwill Swimming Championship will be hosted in Jamaica. As the host country, it is the intention for all age groups to have a full compliment of athletes. This includes age groups in which there are less than four (4) swimmers who have achieved the qualifying standards for selection.

In this event, there will be a selection based criteria based on the following guidelines:

1. The swimmer must be a Jamaican citizen or have been a resident in Jamaica for at least twelve (12) months prior to the entry deadline of the Meet.
2. The swimmer must be registered with the ASAJ at least three (3) weeks prior to the qualifying deadline.
3. Rankings will be compiled from times achieved between December 1st to June 25th of the competition year.
4. Times must have been swum at meets sanctioned by the ASAJ or other World Aquatics recognized bodies.
5. The swimmer must NOT have competed at CARIFTA or other higher level regional or international swimming competitions (CCCAN, CAC, etc) in the same year as the 2023 Goodwill Swimming Championship.
6. Additional swimmers will be selected by the following in priority:
 - a) The number of 1st or 2nd ranked times in qualifying events
 - i) In the event of a tie, the selection will be given to the swimmer with the highest World Aquatics points in the events to which they would qualify
 - b) In the event that there are no swimmers who meet criteria 6a), a swimmer(s) will be selected to be part of a relay team. The relay team will be determined by Hy-Tek based on the combined times of all swimmers in the age group based on the rankings from December 1st to June 25th of the competition year. Swimmer(s) will be selected based on the number of relay teams to which the swimmer would contribute.
 - i.) In the event of a tie, the selection will be given to the swimmer(s) with the highest World Aquatics points in the events to which they would qualify.
