

## **SELECTION CRITERIA 2024 World Aquatics Championships**

- 1. Swimmers must comply with all World Aquatics eligibility rules listed under Section 3 of the World Aquatics Competition Regulations.
- 2. Swimmer must be registered with the ASAJ no less than 12 months before the registration deadline of the last qualifying meet and be the holder of a valid Jamaican Passport.
- 3. Qualification Period is as followed:
  - 1) October 1, 2022-December 19, 2023
- 4. Qualifying times must have been achieved at a World Aquatics-sanctioned LCM meet where swimmers can achieve the World Aquatics 'A' or 'B' Standard Entry Times. This includes competitions approved as qualifying events for the World Aquatics Championships Fukuoka 2023 and/or the Olympic Games Paris 2024, provided that the dates fall within the respective qualifying period.
- 5. Obtaining a World Aquatics 'A' Standard Entry Time provides automatic qualification to compete in the event up to a maximum of two (2) competitors who have achieved the 'A' Standard Entry Time per event.
- 6. If there are less than four (4) swimmers who have achieved the A qualifying standard, additional swimmers will be selected to the team until there are two (2) male and two female representatives. These additional swimmers must achieve the following:
  - 1) Be at least 14 (female) or 15 (male) years of age on December 31 of the competition year
  - 2) Athletes will be ranked by highest World Aquatics points for each swimmer's best Olympic event provided another swimmer has not qualified for that event.
- 7. Additional swimmers who have not met criteria #6 but have obtained the "B" standard entry times may be invited by World Aquatics to compete in the championships based on allocation. One (1) swimmer can compete in an event if the eligible swimmers have achieved the "B" Standard Entry Time or slower.
- 8. Swimmers having achieved only one (1) "A" or one "B" entry time are entitled to enter one (1) additional event. This must not be in an event in which the maximum number of eligible athletes have already been entered.
- 9. Swimmers who have not achieved either the A or B Standard Entry time are eligible to enter up to two (2) individual events. This must not be in an event that a swimmer from criteria #5-#7 has entered via either Standard Entry Times.
- 10. A relay team will be selected based on the following standards listed by World Aquatics:
  - 1) The current standards of participating in the relays at the World Aquatics Championships in which a team can comprise of:
    - 1. Any swimmers entered in individual events even if they have not achieved a "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time for the corresponding stroke and distance of the relay in which they are entered;
    - 2. Additional swimmers as relay-only competitors, provided that they have achieved the "B" Standard Entry Time for the corresponding stroke and distance of the relay in which they are entered.
  - 2) By recording a true relay time that is equal to or faster than the listed relay qualifying time standards (listed in Appendix A); and/or
  - 3) By calculating the times from four different swimmers that is equal to or faster than the listed relay qualifying time standard(s) achieved at any of the qualifying events for World Championships Doha 2024.
