SELECTION CRITERIA 2025 World Aquatics Championships (Swimming)

- 1. Swimmers must comply with all World Aquatics sport nationality eligibility rules listed under Part 1 (Section 3) of the World Aquatics Competition Regulations. See https://resources.fina.org/fina/document/2024/07/23/44b81452-f720-471f-8d07-40e1387dd2fb/Competition-Regulations-version-1st-July-2024-publishing-V3.pdf
- 2. Swimmer must be registered with the ASAJ no less than 3 weeks before the registration deadline of the last qualifying date listed in criteria #3 and be the holder of a valid Jamaican Passport which expires no earlier than January 27, 2026.
- 3. Qualification Period is as followed:
 - 1) **09 March 2024 31 May 2025**
- 4. Qualifying times must have been achieved at a World Aquatics-sanctioned LCM meet where swimmers can achieve the World Aquatics 'A' or 'B' Standard Entry Times.
- 5. If there are less than four (4) swimmers who have achieved the A or B qualifying standard, additional swimmers will be selected to the team until there are two (2) male and two female representatives. These additional swimmers must achieve the following:
 - 1) Be at least 14 years of age on December 31 of the competition year. Younger competitors may participate if they have achieved at least the "B" Standard Entry Time in the respective event.
- 6. Athletes will be ranked by highest World Aquatics points for each swimmer's best event provided another swimmer has not qualified for that event.
- 7. A swimmer ratified with higher AQUA points will not have the first choice to swim individual events in which he/she has not qualified. The swimmer entered will be the highest ranked swimmer on the team in that individual event.
