COACHES' SELECTION CRITERIA FOR CARIFTA AND CCCAN

The primary purpose of these selection criteria for Coach of the CARIFTA AND CCCAN national teams is in an effort to ensure an objective process. A secondary purpose is to establish institutional memory within the ASAJ so when transitions occur they are done smoothly and as objectively as possible.

Coaches will be selected who can foster a positive environment in which teams perform to the best of their ability; manage the final preparations of athletes and the relationship with their personal coaches; and demonstrate an ability to cooperation with the Team Management and follow the Team Manager's direction.

To be eligible for nomination as Coach for CARIFTA AND CCCAN national teams, a Coach must:

- 1. Be a Jamaican citizen and holder of a valid Jamaican passport
- 2. Be registered with the ASAJ in good standing
- 3. Possess a minimum Level 2 Coaches' Certification (FINA, ASCA) for Head Coach and Level 1 for Assistant Coach
- 4. Have at least two (2) swimmers on the team for the position of Head Coach and at least one (1) swimmer for Assistant Coach
- 5. Have no outstanding disciplinary action pending against him/her or currently under suspension from the ASAJ or under investigation for a criminal offence or has previous infractions of the ASAJ's Code of Conduct
- 6. Must have participated in National Squad training camps
- 7. Have prior experience in coaching national teams at the regional and/or international levels
